
Results from the WIT Participant Survey

To date the WIT Survey has been completed by 188 participants (out of 250) from the Asia region. Below are the results of the survey halfway through the Women In Technology pilot program (February 2005).

When asked:

Are you learning skills that will be valuable to you in your future career?

91% responded "Yes"

9% responded "Maybe/Somewhat"

0% responded "No"

Would you recommend this course (the Cisco Networking Academy course) to other women?

96% responded "Yes"

3.5% responded "Maybe"

0.5% responded "No"

Did you meet people in the training with whom you will stay in contact, collaborate or work with in the future?

61% responded "Yes"

29% responded "Maybe"

10% responded "No"

Did you find it beneficial to study in a class with women only?

58.5% responded "Yes"

32% responded "Somewhat"

9.5% responded "No"

Do you think that the training will help you achieve greater economic security and independence?

84% responded "Yes"

16% responded "Maybe"

0% responded "No"

Are you willing to serve as a mentor or role model to girls and women interested in pursuing a career in Information Technology?

92% responded "Yes"

7.5% responded "Maybe"

0.5% responded "No"

How do you find the level of difficulty of the training?

87% responded "Challenging, but right for my level"

7% responded "Too difficult"

6% responded "Easy/not difficult or challenging at all"

How would you rate the CCNA curriculum and course work?

40% responded "Excellent"

42% responded "Very good"

17% responded "Good"

1% responded "Fair"

80% responded "Yes, very helpful"
